Incident Title: Falling Object

#### <u>Summary</u>

An Employee was working off a ladder doing overhead piping/bracing. The worker was called down from their ladder to answer a few questions, and set their drill/impact with Philips tip on top of the ladder.

While they were on the ground, they repositioned the ladder, the drill fell off, and the Philips tip punctured their wrist.



### What Went Right?

• Worker stopped the bleeding, and immediately put ice on their wrist to reduce the swelling

### What Went Wrong?

- Placing anything on a ledge, including a ladder step, is creating a falling object hazard
- Moving a ladder before clearing it of all items

## Lessons Learned

- Before moving a ladder, make sure there aren't any items left of the ladder steps that could fall
- Don't place items on a ledge, step, or any place they could fall to a lower level
