 <u>What Went Right?</u> Worker reported it immediately to supervisor First Aid was provided Supervisor immediately took injured worker to the clinic 	 <u>What Went Wrong?</u> Worker was not wearing cut resistance gloves Failure to train worker on the required use of PPE
Always wear the proper PPE.	

• Review the daily pre-task-plan to ensure all tasks have been identified and the required PPE is available and ready to use.
