## Incident Title: Worker installs sink, slices thumb on sink's edge – no gloves

Summary While installing a stainless-steel sink, a Apollo worker slid his right thumb against the edge of the sink and sliced it open. Injury required stitches.	
<ul> <li><u>What Went Right?</u></li> <li>Worker reported it immediately to supervisor</li> <li>First Aid was provided</li> <li>Supervisor immediately took injured worker to the clinic</li> </ul>	<ul> <li><u>What Went Wrong?</u></li> <li>Worker was not wearing cut resistance gloves</li> <li>Failure to train worker on the required use of PPE</li> </ul>
Always wear the proper PPE.	

• Review the daily pre-task-plan to ensure all tasks have been identified and the required PPE is available and ready to use.
