Crew was directed to remove a drain pipe that was	X
incorrectly installed. During removal a portion of	
the pipe got caught on a riser clamp which was	
hidden below. This caused the no hub band to slip	
off the pipe which resulted in a 14.5" piece of pipe	
to fall to the floor below missing the trash bin	
placed below.	
What Went Right?	What Went Wrong?
<ul> <li>A trash bin was placed below the work zone</li> <li>No one was working directly below</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Initial drain body installed was not the correct elevation</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Insufficient management of crew and the task assigned</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Foreman did not provide barricades or PTP for the crew</li> </ul>

## Lessons Learned

- Develop a PTP template with foreman and safety to ensure PTP is easily available when needed 6
- Review barricading requirements and ensure that spotter is available when needed
- Ensure that work area is fully inspected prior to starting--even on short notice tasks
