Injury Free Workplace

In 2022, Apollo as a company performed almost 5 million manhours and reported 156 first aid injuries, 37 recordable incidents, 17 restricted work injuries and no lost time incidents. That is an incident rate of 1.48 with an industry average of 2.8. Working for Apollo means you are almost 100% less likely to be injured while at work. Here is a reminder on how we continue our success with the foundations of our key elements for an injury free workplace.

The key elements of this process consist of the following:

Leadership: Inspires and exemplifies "Home Healthy - Home Safe" as a core value. **Behavior:** Motivate workers to choose and commit to Healthier and Safer behaviors.

Environment: Provide workspaces that are functionally supportive of a culture of Health and Safety.
