Summary

Apollo Family Member's PU Truck was struck while legally parked outside his Reno, NV residence. The incident occurred on Sunday evening, October 9, 2022.



What Went Right?

- 1) The vehicle was legally parked.
- 2) The Apollo Family Member completed a visual inspection of the PU truck on the afternoon of Sunday October 9, 2022 while cleaning it.



What Went Wrong?

1) Even though the vehicle was legally parked, someone hit the Apollo vehicle and ran.

Lessons Learned

- 1) Keeping an Apollo vehicle clean and tidy is a sure way of facilitating a vehicle inspection. Also, a clean vehicle is great advertising.
- 2) Apollo Family Members clean and inspect company provided vehicles on their only day off (Sunday). Some Family Members take pride in representing the Apollo Organization.
- 3) Vehicle accidents are preventable unless:
 - a. The vehicle is hit by someone else while legally parked.
 - b. The vehicle is involved in an animal strike.
 - c. The vehicle is hit by a flying object (rock, piece of another vehicle, etc.).
 - d. A power wire, low or high voltage, is torn down that was not at least 10' 6" above the ground.
