

## Lessons Learned Mountain (Reno) Region: 8/23/2023 Date: Incident Title: Metering Device Struck-by Project: American Battery Technology **Boom Lift** Corporation Picture Summary Apollo Mechanical Family Member rotated the back Operator sight distances from eye level to ground Eye level 10 ft - 0 in at of a boom lift into a metering box. Nevada Power & Light analyzed the metering box and determined that no damage was inflicted. Scratch on Vehicle: metering device. Distance metering device moved. Boom lift and metering device. What Went Wrong? What Went Right? Apollo Mechanical Family Member: No one was injured. Was working alone. No damage was done. Used equipment without a spotter. Apollo Mechanical incurred the cost of an electrician to have Nevada Power & Light perform a test on the metering devide to ensure no damage occurred. Multiplying the cost of this incident by a factor of 10 equates to the amount of work Apollo Mechanical will have to perform to make up for this loss. Lessons Learned

- Do not work alone; always have a partner. If you are injured or incapacitated, you may not survive the incident.
- When operating equipment, use a spotter. Large equipment has large blind sports. **95'** of blind spot from basket to back of boom lift.
